Steve Pesta was born in Wyndotte, Michigan and moved to California in the Central Valley in the late 1970's where he grew up in the agricultural rich areas of Tulare County. In 1985, he went to work conducting experiments within the Ag Chemical research community for Dow, BASF and Syngenta. A lot of known Insecticides and Herbicides like Seven and Paraquat were only in their experimental phases, but currently have been in production for almost 30 years.

In 1989 he decided to enlist in the United States Army as an Armor Crewman (Tanker) to where he was initially stationed in West Germany, eventually deploying to Operations Shield and Storm. After his first enlistment, he went to work as a Maintenance Foreman/Planner for Texaco Oil and Refining and Shell Oil Products U.S. to where he was responsible for all equipment and materials in a 75,000 bbl. per day production facility in Bakersfield, California.

In 2001 after the 911 attacks, he went back on active duty for the U.S. Army as a Tank Commander and deployed to Operation Iraqi Freedom II/III, stationed in Balad and Mosul Iraq to where he had taken many assignments including Recruiting and Retention as well as a Military Entrance Processing Station Liaison and counselor for new enlistments.
